Compilation and publication. The standard is maintained by the Joint IET/BSI Technical Committee JPEL/64, the UK National Committee for Wiring Regulations, and published by the IET (formerly IEE). There have been requirements for safe electrical wiring as far back as 1876 and, in 1882, the Society of Telegraph Engineers and Electricians, later to become the Institution of Electrical Engineers (IEE – now part of the IET), published the 'Rules and Regulations for the Prevention of Fire Risks arising from Electric Lighting'. The IEE Wiring Regulations 17th Edition (BS 7671:2008) includes additional sections on special locations that were not included in the previous edition; This leaflet is aimed at people who manage or carry out electrical testing, and gives guidance on controlling risks and preventing or reducing danger arising from these activities.
