The Three Musketeers (French: *Les Trois Mousquetaires* [le tʁwa muskɛtʁ]) is a historical adventure novel written in 1844 by French author Alexandre Dumas. Situated between 1625 and 1628, it recounts the adventures of a young man named d'Artagnan (based on Charles de Batz-Castelmore d'Artagnan ) after he leaves home to travel to Paris, to join the Musketeers of the Guard .What is the name of third musketeer?
